We have a new batch of Swarovski 2 Hole sliders - these are great for bracelets - two strands, beads of your choice in between. These are floral themed and are accented with enamels and I think these have a nice, vintagey feel. The enamel is nicely luminous and complements the rhinestones and the designs well!

We have some cool new Resin beads in too - I called 'em Crackle Gooseberries coz they have a cracked surface and the big olive green ones look like gooseberries.



Although, Cackle Gooseberries might have been a good name too - they are sort of egg-like!

A new supplier of semi-precious stone chips - these are 36 inch strands - so you get LOTSA chips on these.



We have Amazonite, Citrine, Smokey Quartz, Mother of Pearl new this week.
